



VANCOUVER BROADWAY

DIRECTIONS FROM


- Tsawassassen Ferry Terminal
Follow Highway 17 north to Highway 99. Take Highway 99 north over the Oak Street Bridge. Go appx. 60 blocks north on Oak Street until you reach the intersection of Oak Street and West Broadway. Turn right on West Broadway and hotel is one block up on right side
- U.S. / Canada Border
Interstate 5 turns into Highway 99 in Canada, stay on Highway 99, go thru George Massey Tunnel. Stay on Highway 99 over Oak Street Bridge, continue on Oak Street for appx. 60 blocks. Turn right on West Broadway, the hotel is one block on the right.
- Whistler / Squamish / Horseshoe Bay
Follow the TransCanada I / Highway 99 East and take the Taylor Way exit. Go south down the hill on Taylor Way until you get to a major intersection of Taylor Way and Marine Drive. Turn left at the lights, get into the right lane immediately and onto the Lions Gate Bridge. Over the bridge, thru Stanley Park Causeway and onto Georgia Street. Follow Georgia Street and make a right onto Burrard Street. Turn left on West Broadway (top of hill) and the hotel is appx. 9 blocks up on the right side.
- TransCanada Highway West
Take the Grandview Highway exit. Grandview turns into 12th Ave. (east then west), continue straight thru until Oak Street. Turn right on Oak Street, down 3 blocks until West Broadway. Turn right onto West Broadway, the hotel is one block up on the right side.
- Airport
Take the Grant McConachie Way out from the airport over the Arthur Laing bridge heading towards Vancouver. Take the Granville Street exit, follow Granville Street appx. 60 blocks and turn right on West Broadway. The hotel is 6 blocks up on the right.

Bus:

Get off at the Willow Stop of the 99 B-line bus.

When on the Trip Planner, enter; "898 Broadway" for our hotel location and then select "West Broadway". When going to or from the Airport select "Transportation Centres" and then "AIRPORT – YVR" or "AIRPORT - SOUTH TERMINAL" depending on which terminal you are traveling through.




To from the Airport (Canada and Line)

Enjoy easy access to and from the airport via the Canada Line. The Broadway City Hall Station is only 4 blocks away from the hotel and provides convenient transportation to and from Vancouver International Airport (YVR). Approximately cost \$3.75 one way to the airport. Please note that travelers from YVR are subject to an additional \$5 Add Fare when traveling from the airport.

If a guest at the airport skytrain station, purchase a ticket from one of the three machines, the machine would charge \$3.75 for 2 zones + \$5.00 additional (building fee) anytime before 6:30 pm. However, there are stores within the airport such as the **Pharmasave** and **7-Eleven**, etc where guests can purchase a 2 zone ticket for \$3.75 and the guests just need to validate this is in the machine. If they do this, they will not be charged the \$5.00 additional YVR Add fare fee. Please note that the fee after 6.30 pm is only \$2.50 for adults, additional \$5.00 if they purchase the tickets from the machine. At any time, children from 4 yrs and under travels for free, 5 to 13 years old pays the concession and 14 yrs and up, pays the adult fees. Make sure you validate any tickets bought from the above mentioned stores from validating machines also located within stations.

To and from the Vancouver Convention Centre or the Cruise Terminal at Canada Place.



Time from hotel: 6 min (1 zone), cost \$2.5 (subject to change)
Canada Place and the convention Centre is easily accessible from Waterfront Station. TransLink provides city transit seven days a week via its rapid transit system - the SkyTrain. SkyTrain lines that serve Waterfront Station include: Canada Line and Millenium Line. The Westcoast Express is another system that connects guests easily to Waterfront Station.

The Canada Line YVR Add Fare (\$5.00)

If you will be using the Canada Line to travel from Vancouver International Airport (YVR) to Bridgeport Station and beyond, you need to know about the Canada Line YVR AddFare that takes effect on Monday, January 18, 2010.

Where does the Canada Line YVR AddFare apply and how much does it cost?

The Canada Line YVR AddFare is applicable to inbound travel departing from any of the stations on Sea Island (YVR-Airport, Sea Island Centre and Templeton) destined for Bridgeport Station or points beyond. The Canada Line YVR AddFare is \$5.00 in addition to your zone fare.

Who pays the new Canada Line YVR AddFare?

Canada Line customers travelling from YVR-Airport, Sea Island Centre and Templeton stations to Bridgeport Station or beyond, who buy their fare zone ticket from a Ticket Vending Machine using cash, debit card or credit card must pay the \$5.00 Canada Line YVR AddFare. This includes concession (seniors and students) fares. Children under the age of 5 can ride transit for free and are not subject to the YVR AddFare.
